- Added more than 50k digital images to collection via Luna Insight






#### **FY06 Libraries Sources of Funds**

•Coffee shop services in libraries requested both by faculty and undergraduate students	•Added to Anschutz and Watson			



#### **Humanities Faculty- LibQUAL FY03 (continued)**

Issue Raised	Action Taken			
•Watson not sufficiently accessible for users with disabilities	•Installed electronic mechanism for automated entry to Watson front doors (level 3). Level 2 access made available by appointment			
•Desire for improved ILL services	•Implemented local article delivery from print journals. Number of ILL items provided increased by 28% from FY03 thru FY06			
•Inoperable microform reader/ printers	•purchased additional unit			



# Humanities Faculty LibQUAL FY06 Issues Raised

- Communication
- Service quality
- Computers in stacks
- Repurposing of space
- Equipment maintenance

- Stacks cleanliness
- Storage vs. browsing
- Extended loan periods for faculty
- •Replacement of lost items
