



## \$2.7M gift made to support Hall Center

A \$2.7 million gift from the Hall Family Foundation will provide lasting support for the Hall Center for the Humanities at KU. The gift includes \$500,000 to establish a distinguished professorship in the collaborative humanities, \$1 million to create a postdoctoral fellowship in the digital humanities and \$1 million to establish a mid-career fellowship in the humanities. It also includes \$210,000 to support Hall Center initiatives during the next three years.
