I urge you to keep up-to-date on the situation by reading any information coming via email from the Chancellor and the Provost, and know our university administrators are working hard to advocate on KU's behalf.

In the meantime, we will continue efforts here to ensure our organization is best aligned to address our new strategic priorities, and to continue the vital work we do in supporting research, teaching and learning on campus.

I look forward to sharing more information as soon as it becomes available.
