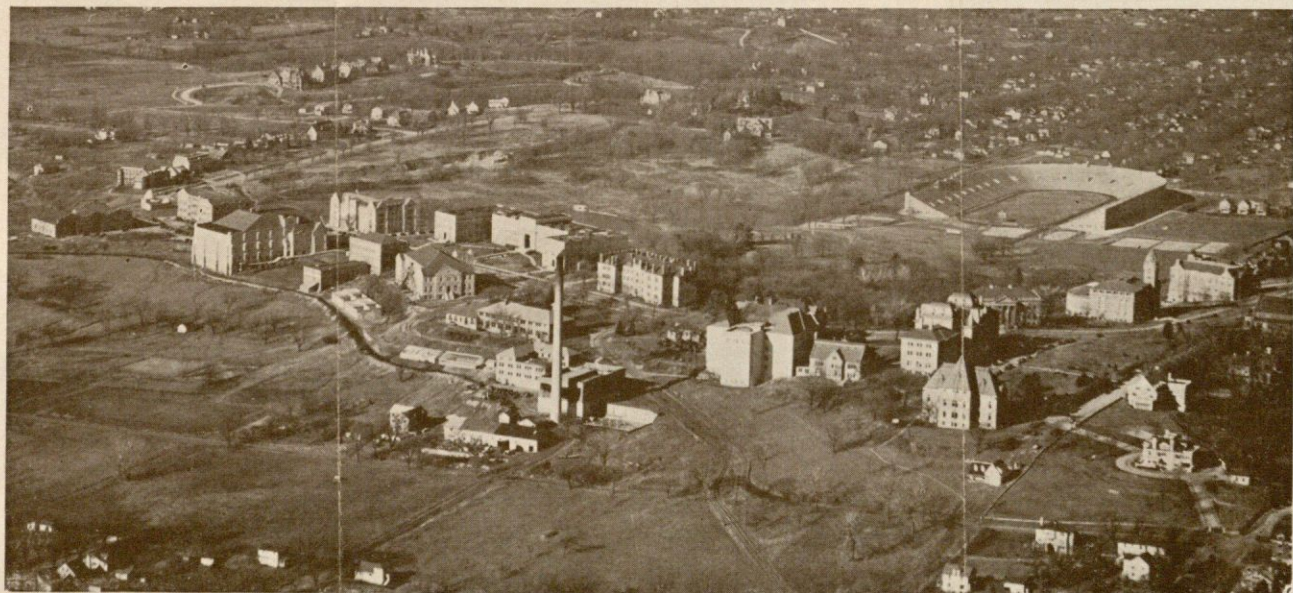


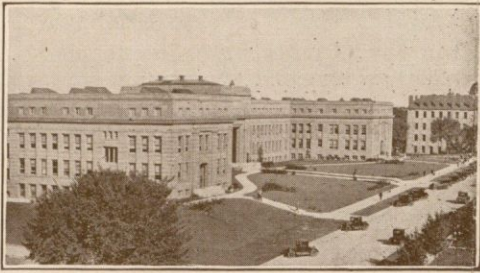
A 1930 View of the University of Kansas Campus from the Southeast

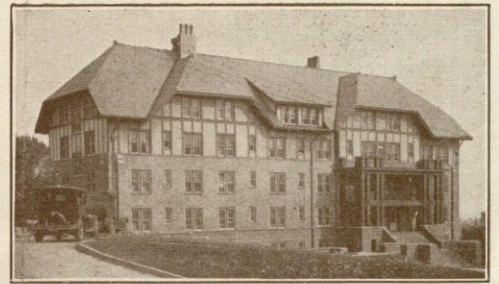

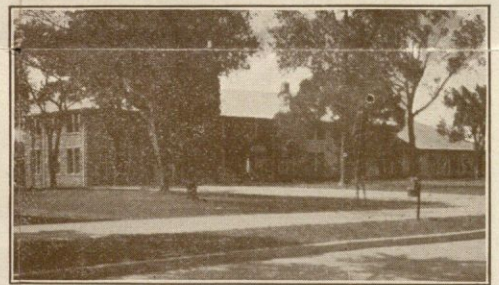

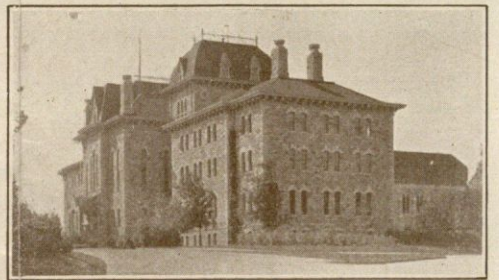

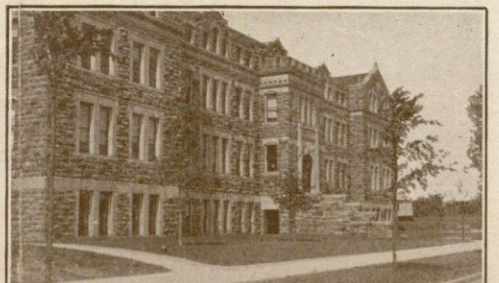
