


Campus construction: 'crumbling classrooms' get facelift

The University of Kansas'
Lawrence campus is in the midst of a major overhaul of many of its buildings. Ongoing renovation and construction projects abound. New construction will begin this fall. And more projects are in the works.

As of Fall 1999, there are more than 30 consultants, 50 architects and engineers, 28 general contractors and 198 sub contractors working on the projects.

Some of the money came from a "crumbling classrooms" allocation to Kansas Board of Regents schools from the state legislature. Private donations are financing other projects.
