Current Status of East Asian Collections in American Libraries, 1987/1988

The survey results of the East Asia collections in United States and Canadian libraries for 1987/88 are here published a second time. When we first sent out questionnaires, we received data from forty-three libraries. After the survey results had been published in the February issue of the *CEAL Bulletin*, three more libraries sent in their responses. We decided to publish this updated version to incorporate the additional data. In addition, we have also taken the opportunity to correct a few typographical errors. With the publication of this updated version, please disregard the survey results published in the February issue (No. 86) of the *CEAL Bulletin*.

For the next two years, we plan to make the survey an annual feature of the *Bulletin*. In order to have sufficient time for the survey to appear in the February issue, we probably will have to move up the timetable for submitting information. We will contact you soon with the specifics.

Current Status of East Asian Collections in American Libraries, 1987/88

This survey of the East Asia collections in United States and Canadian libraries for 1987/88 provides the latest data on the current status of resources, growth rate, personnel, and cataloging. Questionnaires were sent out to all the institutions listed in the 1987 CEAL Directory. Of these, forty-three supplied data. No attempt has been made to tabulate or analyze the results, but we believe that the mere availability of these figures is valuable for our operations. The format as it appears here is slightly different from similar surveys made earlier to make more room for figures.
