- Added more than 50k digital images to collection via Luna Insight




Points of Pride (cont.)




FY06 Libraries Sources of Funds

Some Observations among ARLs

•Requested more access to electronic journals	•Expenditures for electronic resources increased by 25% from FY03 thru FY05				
•Poor copier service	•Contracted with external provider for public copier services				
•Desire for improved ILL services	•Implemented local article delivery from print journals. Number of ILL items provided increased by 28% from FY03 thru FY06				
•Website difficult to utilize	•Redesigned website based on usability studies – simplified libraries home page				



Science & Technology Faculty LibQUAL FY06 Issues Raised

- Want more journals (reduce journal cuts)
- Provide more electronic access to information, particularly in full text format
- Delivery of books to remote sites (i.e. West Campus)
- Provide electronic access to medical library holdings

New Initiatives

- Electronic transmission of requested inhouse journal articles
- Campus delivery service (pilot test now)

- Repurpose other library spaces
- Enhance service quality
- Identify needs for faculty workshops
