

Researchers recreate Jurassic love song

University of Kansas researcher Michael Engel and scientists from China and the United Kingdom have again played what may be the world's oldest love song. Using an exquisitely preserved mid-Jurassic katydid fossil found in China, the researchers have recreated the insect's mating call produced by "stridulation" — the rubbing together of musical wing parts.
