M I N U T E S

May 14, 1917

1. Ordered that Dean P. F. Walker, Professors W. W. Davis, James Naismith, H. A. Roberts, all on permanent appointment, be granted leaves of absence for service in the army of the United States during the present war and that they receive while in service their present salary less the amount they receive from the Federal Government.

2. Ordered that Assistant Professor J. E. Todd of the department of geology be placed on half time service and receive half of his present salary, and that he render such service to the University as may be required of him.

3. Ordered that Assistant Professor Charles Cochran be granted leave of absence for one year from September 1, 1917 without salary.

4. Ordered that Roy R. Irwin be appointed Assistant in the Food Laboratory for a period of three months to begin April 1, 1917 at a salary of \$85 per month.

5. Ordered that Mrs. May Phillips be appointed stenographer and clerk in the department of chemistry for a period of two months beginning May 1, 1917 at a salary of \$50 per month.

6. Ordered that the amount of \$165 now remaining in the traveling fund of the Dean of the School of Education be transferred to the Apparatus Fund of the Oread Training School.

7. Ordered that the following be granted fellowships in the University of Kansas for the year 1917-18:
