

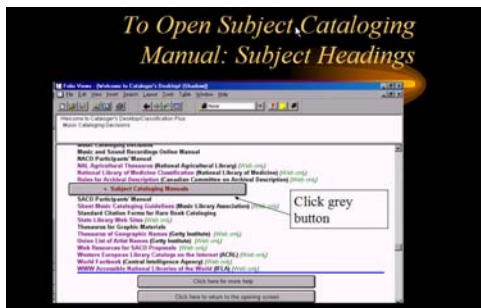

How KU Libraries staff are using SnagIt

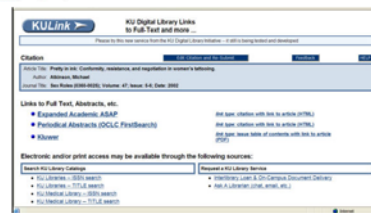
Internal documentation within departments


