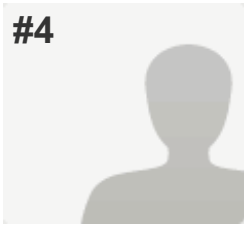

The Medical and BioScience Academy (MBSA) of Longmont High School is designed for students interested in careers or post-secondary education rooted in the health sciences. One of the elective classes is Nutrition and Wellness. The students in this class will create public service announcements for the LHS community. Some will be aired on our morning announcements while others will be shared with health teachers to play when relevant to the curriculum. They will also host a wellness fair with some hands on activities related to their topic in the library at lunch. Some of the topics will include: type 2 diabetes, vaccinations, proper sleep and eating habits, smoking, texting and driving and the reasons to limit screen time. In addition to our online databases, students will use medlineplus to gather information related to their topic.

Q8: How will the project funding be allocated?

\$150 Whiteboard paint, small whiteboards, White board markers: \$150

\$500 Props for the PSA: This will be determined by what students need but some examples include models, plastic samples of healthy and unhealthy snacks, simple objects and props to make the videos more engaging such as microphones for a talk show.

\$300 Supplies for hands on learning activities to follow-up the videos during the hands on health fair. Again this will be determined by student needs but will include clay, models, etc...

\$150 iPad tripods for filming
