4. Please provide the rate used to compute the overhead.

Kansas State University has a 34% requirement for indirect cost/overhead. Of that 34%, 14.8% is allocated to the Dean of the respective college submitting a grant application. For this award, the Dean of Veterinary Medicine waived his portion (14.8%) in order to support our proposed project. Therefore, rate used to compute the overhead is 19.2%. This is allocated to the Office of Research and Sponsored Programs at Kansas State University.

5. Please provide clarification on the training to be done at each conference.

The main intent of the project is to participate in the exhibits at each conference. During these exhibits, the investigators will: discuss and provide materials on NLM products and databases with conference attendees, provide one-on-one and small group demonstrations of NLM

products and databases using a laptop computer, and schedule at least two in-booth group demonstrations of NLM products and databases during each conference. These group demonstrations will be advertised in the booth with posters and signage.
