a. Manuscript Processing Fee: A processing fee of \$5.00 in check or money-order payable to the *Mid-American Review of Sociology* must accompany each article submitted. Manuscripts will not be reviewed until the fee has been paid. This fee is waived for all submissions from authors at sponsoring institutions and for submissions accompanied by a floppy disk of the text, preferably in one of the following formats: IBM format (WordPerfect, Microsoft Word, or WordStar), or Macintosh format (Mirosoft Word).

b. Authors must submit 4 copies of each manuscript, along with an abstract of 100 words. Authors must also include a self-addressed stamped postcard for notification of receipt of the manuscript. All manuscripts and editorial correspondence should be addressed to the Article Review Editor, *Mid-American Review of Sociology*, Department of Sociology, University of Kansas, Lawrence, KS 66045. Articles should follow the citation system of the *American Sociological Review*. All articles submitted **must** use gender neutral language.

c. *Mid-American Review of Sociology* is published semiannually, Spring (May) and Winter (December), by the sponsoring institutions. Claims for undelivered copies must be made within six months following the publication dates. The publishers will supply missing copies when losses have been sustained in transit if the reserve stock will permit.

d. Subscriptions are entered on a calendar year basis. Subscription rates are: Students \$6/yr.; Individuals \$8/yr.; Departments \$10/yr.; and Institutions \$20/yr. Canadian subscriptions add \$3.00 for postage and handling to all rates. Overseas subscriptions add \$7. Back issues are available for \$5 each.

e. Advertising rates are: Full page, \$50; Half page, \$25. A 20% discount will be granted advertisers inserting ads in two or more consecutive issues.

f. Business matters, permission to quote, subscriptions, and changes of address should be sent to the Managing Editor, *Mid-American Review of Sociology*, Department of Sociology, University of Kansas, Lawrence, KS 66045.

g. Institutions interested in becoming affiliated with *MARS* should contact the Editor. Sponsorship fees for Ph.D.-granting institutions are \$150; for M.A.-granting institutions, \$100; for B.A.-granting institutions, \$50; and for sustaining institutions, \$250. A sustaining institution is a commercial establishment or research institute that would like to support the advancement of sociological knowledge.
